Group Research:

With your group, select a college/university you would like to learn more about from the following website:

<https://k20.ou.edu/hbculist>. The Hundred-Seven provides a list of 107 Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs). From the list, select one you are interested in researching and go directly to the school's website. Once you have selected the college/university, use the Note Organizer below to guide your research, which will be later turned into a visual One-Pager. Use the information directly from the college/university website. If you used anything else to guide your research, be sure to include those resources in the "Source of Information" column of the Note Organizer. Once your group completes the Note Organizer, create a One-Pager that addresses the guiding questions.

One-Pager Instructions & Requirements:

Once you have completed your research, your group will create a One-Pager to provide a visual representation of the college/university you chose. Include key points from the Note Organizer. Below are guidelines to follow:

- **Visually strong and appealing:** Include images on your chart. The images can be used to summarize some of your written responses from the Note Catcher.
- **Mixture of words:** Include your written response in a shortened format. Use key phrases, words that stand out, or short sentences.
- **Represent the essence of your school:** Keep the school's colors, mascot, and culture in mind and represent that on your poster.
- **Formatting and grammar:** Make sure it is easy to read and the information is clearly listed. Double check spelling, grammar, and typographical errors.

Guiding Questions	Notes	Sources
College/University Overview: What is the name of the college/university you chose? Where (city and state) is this college/university located?		
College/University History: Give a short summary. When were it founded? Is it private or public? Was there a specific purpose for founding this college/university?		
Admission Requirements: What are the admission requirements for first year students? Does it require standardized test scores? If so, which one? What is the minimum score? Is there a minimum GPA score or class rank, etc.?		

Guiding Questions	Notes	Sources
<p>Cost of Attendance: How much does it cost to attend this school? This information can usually be found under the “Admissions Tab” under Financial Aid.</p>		
<p>Academic Programs: What academic programs do they offer? Is the college/university known for a specific program? Which program are you interested in? Why?</p>		
<p>Extracurricular Activities: What sports are offered that interest you? What club or organization interests you? (e.g. marching bands, fraternities/sororities, student governing organizations, special interest clubs, service or religious groups.)</p>
