## **Group Research**

## **Anchor Chart**

As a group, use your research notes to create an Anchor Chart that provides a visual representation of your chosen college or university. Your chart must include ALL of the following:

- Information from every category in the Notes Organizer presented in a concise format Summarize your written responses from the Notes Organizer using key words or phrases or another method of your choice to make important information stand out.
- Strong and appealing visual elements

You can either print images or draw your own. The images can also be used to help summarize or present some of your written responses from the Notes Organizer.

- A representation that captures the essence of your school Keep the school's colors, mascot, and culture in mind and represent them on your chart.
- Clear formatting and correct grammar

Your chart should be easy to read and appealing to look at. Double-check for spelling, typos, and grammar.

College/University History Give a summary of the school's history. When was it founded? Is it private or public? Was there a specific purpose for founding this college/university?

Admission Requirements What are the admission requirements for freshmen? (List all requirements. For example, does the school require standardized test scores? If so, which one and what is the minimum score? Is there a minimum GPA score or class rank?)		
Cost of Attendance How much does it cost to attend this school? (This information can usually be found under the Admissions tab under Financial Aid. Keep in mind that this number is before financial assistance is applied.)		

Guiding Questions	Notes	Source (Where did you get this information?)
Academic Programs What academic programs does the school offer? Is it known for a specific program? Which program are you most interested in researching and why?		
Extracurricular Activities What sports does the school offer? Which one stands out to you and why? Which club or organization stood out to you and why? (These might include bands, fraternities/sororities, student governing organizations, or service groups.)
