TestNav: Getting Started


- 1) Navigate to home.testnav.com. Then click “The ACT” button.

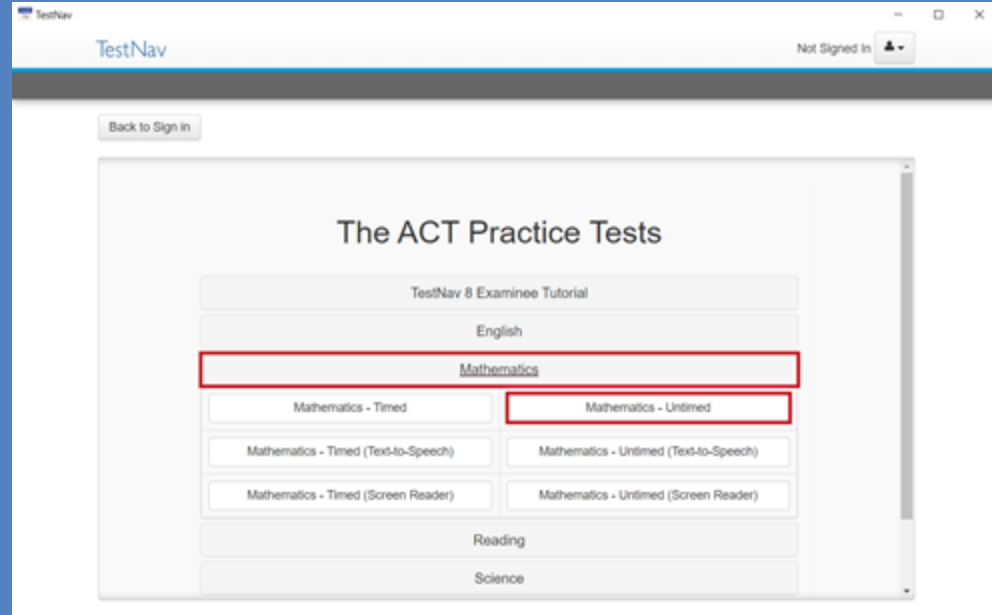

- 4) Select “Mathematics - Untimed.”



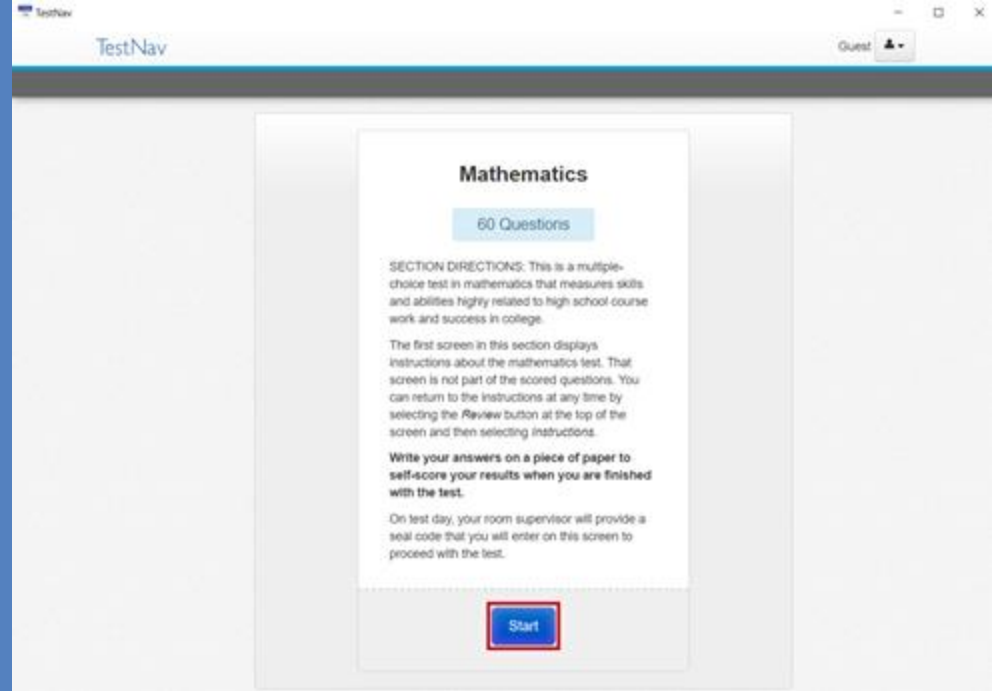
TestNav: Advice

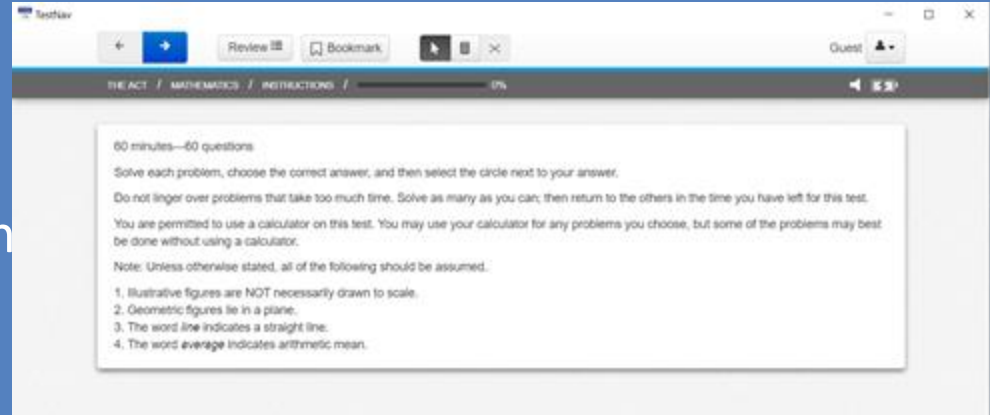
- 7) Read the directions.

9) Read the directions.

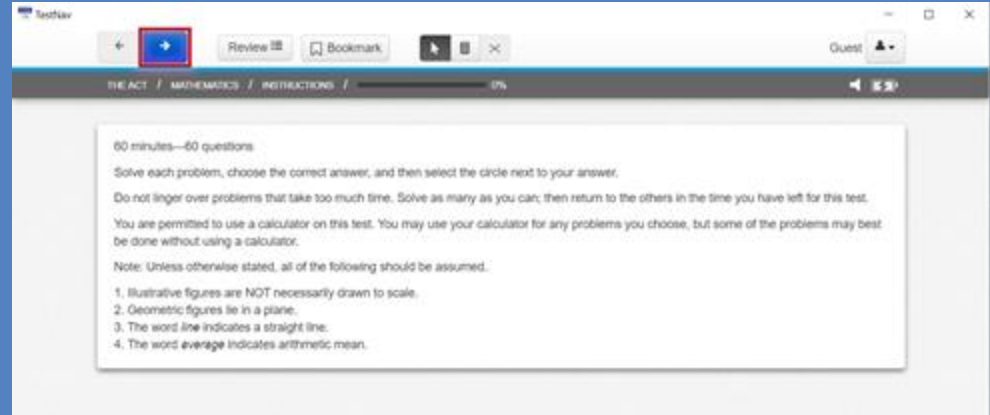
- Read these now so that you do not spend time on the actual ACT reading these same directions.

Begin Your Practice Test

10) Press the “Next” (arrow) button at the top of the screen to begin.



Start and End Times

- Write the start and end times on the board.
- Example:
 - Start at 9:00 am
 - End at 9:25 am

5-Minute Warning

- When students are not using the full time to take a full practice test, they will not see the usual reminder indicating that 5 minutes remains.
- Alert students that there are 5 minutes remaining.

TestNav: End the Practice Test

- 1) Navigate to the “End of the Section.”
- 2) Click the “Submit Final Answers” button.
