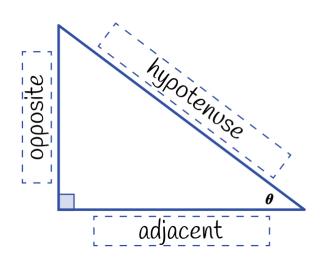

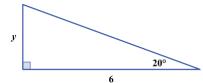


$$\sin\theta = \frac{opposite}{hypotenuse}$$

$$\cos\theta = \frac{adjacent}{hypotenuse}$$

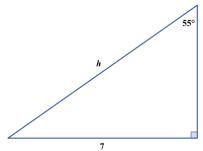
$$\tan \theta = \frac{opposite}{adjacent}$$

Find the Missing Side:



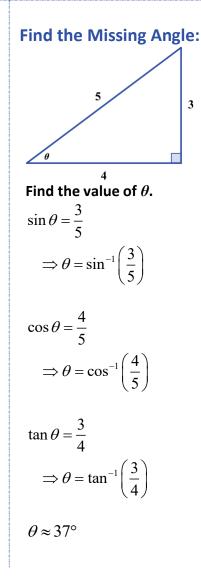
Find the value of y.

$$\tan (20^\circ) = \frac{y}{6}$$
$$\Rightarrow y = 6 \cdot \tan (20^\circ)$$
$$\Rightarrow y \approx 2.2$$



Find the value of *h*.

$$\sin(55^\circ) = \frac{7}{h}$$
$$\Rightarrow h = \frac{7}{\sin(55^\circ)}$$
$$\Rightarrow h \approx 8.5$$

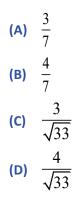
