



Answers | Fragments

Explanations	Examples
Join simple sentences with punctuation or conjunctions.	X The pin is hers, the hat is mine.
	\checkmark The pin is hers, and the hat is mine.

Answers | Verb Tense

Explanations	Examples
Make sure verb tense and voice between simple clauses, simple adjoining sentences, and entire sentences match the subject (s).	 ✗ Yesterday, I went to Sarah's place, and I take an Uber. ✓ Yesterday, I went to Sarah's place, and I took an Uber.
Use consistent and logical verb tense and pronoun references throughout the entire work.	 School dress codes were not adopted in the US until 1969, but the basic idea for such a system has been proposed years earlier. School dress codes were not adopted in the US until 1969, but the basic idea for such a system had been proposed years earlier.

Answers | Sentence Structure

Explanations	Examples
A misplaced modifier is placed too far from the word(s) it adds meaning to.	 She wore a bicycle helmet on her head <u>that was too</u> <u>large</u>. She wore a bicycle helmet that was too large for her head .
Parallelisms repeat grammatical elements (like noun/verb phrases) to create and emphasize memorable phrases and flow.	 Strategy for developing speaking skills includes using minimal response, how to recognize scripts, and using language to discuss language. ACT English Subject Tips



Answer Choices

- It's okay to choose "NO CHANGE" as it is just as likely to be as correct as any other option.
- If you're running out of time or just don't know the answer, make an educated guess.
 - "Often, the most concise answer is the correct one" versus the longer wordier answer choices.
