Correct Definitions

- Context: the circumstances, conditions, or objects by which one is surrounded

- Tone: style or manner of expression in speaking or writing

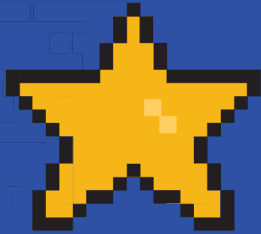
The Things They Carried: Answers
