
TestNav: Selecting the Right Test

TestNav: Advice


- 5) Read the directions.


TestNav: Online English Section Directions

The ACT: General English Section Directions


- 9) Read the directions.

Begin Your Practice Test

10) Press the “Next” (arrow) button at the top of the screen to begin.



Start and End Times

- Write the start and end times on the board.
- Example:
 - Start at 9:00 am
 - End at 9:27 am

5-Minute Warning

- Since students are not using the full time to take a full practice test, they will not see the usual reminder indicating that 5 minutes remains.
- Alert students that there are 5 minutes remaining.

TestNav: End the Practice Test

- 1) Navigate to the “End of the Section.”
- 2) Click the “Submit Final Answers” button.
