REGLA	EXPLICACIÓN
Añade	Añade palabras o frases para aclarar el significado.
Elimina	Elimina palabras u oraciones innecesarias.
Mueve	Mueve una palabra, frase u oración para aclarar el significado.
Sustituye	Sustituye o intercambia palabras u oraciones para mejorar el significado o la calidad.
