Meaningful Questions

- Use meaningful questions to frame instructional activities and guide student learning?
- Invite students to ask questions about what they are learning and challenge them to find the answers?
- Provide an appropriate structure to help students work systematically toward a complex solution or explanation?
- Ask students to construct an explanation or argument with supporting evidence and reasoning to show their learning?

Productive Discourse

- Create opportunities for students to share ideas and respond to the ideas of others?
- Guide students to seek understanding through productive, solution-based conversation?
- Ask students to collaborate with others to gain a shared understanding of ideas from multiple perspectives?
