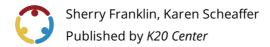




Tutoring Tool Kit: Goal Review

Discussion Questions

To guide this week's discussion, consider asking the following questions:

- Did you meet the goal you set for yourself in this course?
- What did you do well this semester?
- What is something you learned in tutoring that has been helpful?
- What did you learn about yourself while completing this course?
- What was the most interesting thing you learned?
- What changes can you make for next semester?

Next Steps

Remind students to:

- Celebrate all the hard work they put into the course.
- Reach out to school staff if they would like to continue tutoring sessions in the future.
