


# ACADEMIC STATION

## *WHAT STORY DOES A TRANSCRIPT TELL?*


Your high school transcript is your official academic record. It shows the courses you've taken, the grades you've earned, your grade point average (GPA), and your progress towards graduation.

## HOW DO I PAY FOR A PSE?




You’ve been eyeing a pair of Jordans that cost \$200. You don’t have the money to buy them right now, but you really want them.
