

WHAT IS OKLAHOMA'S PROMISE?

A tuition scholarship program that helps Oklahoma students pay for their education after high school.

You can apply if:

- You live in Oklahoma
- You're in 8th–12th grade*
*As long as you apply by December 31st of your senior year
- You meet certain academic and financial requirements

What Are the Financial Requirements?

It depends on your household income along with how many children are in your family. You can get special provisions if you're adopted, if your parent is a teacher, if your parents receive social security income, or you meet other criteria.



If I Meet the Requirements, What Is the Promise?

Oklahoma's Promise covers the **full cost of tuition** at public colleges and universities in Oklahoma. It covers **some costs of tuition** for private institutions or career techs. Tuition is by far the biggest part of paying for college. It doesn't include the cost of a dorm room, food, or parking passes, among other fees. You can combine Oklahoma's Promise with other scholarships, grants, and waivers to cover those costs.



What If I Don't Live in Oklahoma My Senior Year?

If you are not an Oklahoma resident or you are not eligible for Oklahoma's Promise, there are other options available to help pay for college. Check out K20.ou.edu/StateAid and K20.ou.edu/AidResources.
