Analogies

Definition: An analogy is a relationship where two words or things are compared.

Penguin:Bird

::

Golden Retriever

A penguin is a type of
bird.

→

A Golden Retriever is a
type of dog.

Hat:Head

::

Shoes:Feet

You wear a hat on
your head.

→

You wear shoes on
your feet.

Strong:Weak

::

Love:Hate

Strong is the opposite
of weak.

→

Love is the opposite of
hate.

Have students explain the relationship between the words in the first half of the analogy (penguin:bird), then have them apply that relationship to the second half (golden retriever:dog).
