**Station 1:**

Trilobite (Isotelus) and Trilobite (Carboniferous)

**Station 2:**

T-Rex Tooth Cast (Cretaceous) and Deinonychus “Killer Toe.”

*The question for the students will be “What can you infer by looking at these two parts of the animals’ anatomy?”*

**Station 3:**

Apatosaurus vertebra (long land animal) and Ichthyosaur (#73109) vertebra (short aquatic animal).

**Station 4:**

Aquilops jaw with teeth (#34557) and Epicyon jaw with teeth (#15174)

**Station 5:**

Trimerorachis Skull (eyes on top, #56790)

**Station 6:**

Skull (eyes on side)

**Station 7:**

Reading Station

**Station 8:**

Skull (eyes in front)

**Station 9:**

Oxytripedoceras (Ammonite from Bryan, Oklahoma; Cretaceous)
