Roles	Description
Scene Description	<p>Create at least two “<i>slug lines</i>” that establish the general location, specific location, and time of day. Example: INT. POLICE STATION - BATHROOM - NIGHT.</p> <p>For each <i>slug line</i>, create a scene description in paragraph form that describes the look, feel, weather, and any unique qualities of a setting.</p> <p>Create at least five <i>action lines</i> or <i>scene descriptions</i> written in the present tense that can be assigned to characters during the dialogue.</p>
Dialogue	<p>Write at least two pages of dialogue for two characters. Include <i>dialogue extensions</i> and <i>parentheticals</i> as needed.</p> <p>Make sure to label the dialogue with the characters name centered over what is being said.</p>
Character Descriptions and Post-production	<p>Write two <i>character descriptions</i>. Be descriptive, but brief. EX: TIMMY (21, bleach blonde hair, eyebrow piercing).</p> <p>Write at least two <i>transitions</i>, right-justified in all caps.</p> <p>Write a <i>montage</i> at least a half page in length.</p> <p>Find a song for the montage write the <i>lyrics</i> throughout as needed.</p>
