Read each statement then write the number of the amendment that statement represents. Explain your answer in one or more complete sentences.

4 1) The police must present a search warrant before they enter Allie's house to look for stolen goods.

*Law enforcement must have a warrant before searching private property.*

9 2) Katie and Bryan have a right to public education.

*We have more rights than those listed in the Constitution.*

5 3) Cameron is arrested and he has the right to remain silent.

*You can remain silent to avoid getting yourself into more trouble.*

1 4) Leah, Becca, and Louisa plan to march on Capitol Hill to protest U.S. environmental policies.

*They can peacefully protest or petition for their cause to the government.*

6 5) Cassie is arrested and is required to appear in court for her trial. She cannot afford a lawyer, so the government will provide her with one.

*All citizens have the right to an attorney that will represent them in a court of law.*

2 6) Sarah's dad owns a gun so he can go hunting every deer season.

*Citizens have the right to own and carry weapons if they follow federal and state laws.*

1 7) Evan publishes an article criticizing the President's policies on national security.

*The press has the right to give their opinions about the government and its leaders.*

6 8) Kristin is accused of a crime and is waiting for her trial to be scheduled.

*Those accused of a crime have the right to a trial by a jury of their peers.*

8 9) Certain forms of punishment are illegal.

*Citizens are protected against any excessive or cruel and unusual punishments.*

5 10) Each person who is accused of a crime goes through the same process before the court can sentence them to prison.

*A citizen can't be found guilty of a crime without going through due process of law.*
