

OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW

At Oklahoma State University, **ALL STUDENTS** are encouraged to apply because we individually review each application for our holistic and alternative admission programs. We consider many factors, including: high school GPA, ACT or SAT scores, responses to application essays, academic letters of recommendation, leadership experience, community involvement and accomplishments.

ASSURED ADMISSION

Students qualify for assured admission if they meet **ONE** of the following criteria:

3.0 GPA or better unweighted cumulative **AND** top 33.3% rank in high school graduating class

OR

3.0 GPA or better in 15-unit core **AND** 21 ACT/980 SAT or better

OR

24 ACT or 1090 SAT or better

*OSU does not consider the writing component of the ACT/SAT for admission criteria listed above.

15-Unit Core Curricular Requirements:

- 4 units of English (Grammar, Composition and Literature)
- 3 units of Mathematics (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II and above)
- 3 units of History and Citizenship Skills (Must include 1 unit of American history and 2 units from the subjects of history, Economics, Geography, Government, Civics and/or Non-Western Culture)
- 3 units lab science (Biology, Chemistry, Physical Sciences, Physics or any lab science certified by school district)
- 2 units of other courses selected from any of the sections above or computer science or foreign language.

Home study or Unaccredited High Schools: Graduates must satisfy the curricular requirements and have either a 1090 SAT or 24 ACT score. Grade-point average and class rank are not used to evaluate students who fall under either category.

Students who have been denied admission may petition the comprehensive review committee's decision one time.
