SOPHOMORE COLLEGE CHECKLIST

- **STUDY, STUDY, STUDY -** keep your grades up
- STRIVE FOR EXCELLENT ATTENDANCE you have to be in school to accomplish your educational goals
- KNOW WHAT COURSES YOU NEED check them off as you go
- **TAKE IT UP A LEVEL** investigate AP and honors-level courses
- LOOK INTO CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTIONS check with your counselor to found out how you might be able to get early college credits in your junior or senior year
- MAKE A FILE keep a file for later with copies of report cards, lists of paid or volunteer school and community activities, lists of awards or honors
- **BE ACTIVE** find ways to participate in extracurricular activities and volunteer work
- PLAN FOR DOING WELL ON THE ACT OR SAT study for standardized tests by going online to find study resources and strategies
- **JOT IT DOWN** start investigating colleges you might want to attend and make a list of pros and cons about each one including location, cost, and academic offerings
- **TALK IT OUT** have conversations with counselors, teachers, parents, and friends about plans after high school and educational choices
- LAST CHANCE Be sure you are signed up for Oklahoma's Promise scholarship program
- **SAVE FOR THE FUTURE** start a college savings plan and contribute regularly with your parents.
