Driving a vehicle (includes motorcycle, 4- wheeler, etc.)	Driver's license, registration, tag, insurance, traffic laws, vehicle inspections, emission controls, tax on gasoline, safety regulations of factories, traffic speeds on roads	
Watching television or going to the movies	Federal Communications Commission controls airwaves and regulates all televisions stations, laws against profanity, nudity and parental controls, movie and broadcast show/movie ratings	
Playing a sport	Rules for the sport, government inspection of equipment for the sport, laws determining the age when the sport can be played, rules about ages, equipment, playing on a public field, safety gear	
Sleeping	Regulations on mattress, pillow and bedding inspections, factory regulations, furniture regulations, Daylight Saving time	
Going to church	Non-profit status, regulations about maintaining non-profit status with IRS, liability insurance, employee regulations, legal separation of Church and State	
Eating in a restaurant	Food inspections, licenses, permits, age requirements of workers, food handling permits
