





## SAFETY SYMBOL CARD SORT

<b>Flammable</b>		<p>Flammable when exposed to heat, fire, or sparks. Could give off flammable gases when reacting with water. Ignition sources should be avoided.</p>
<b>Corrosive</b>		<p>May cause burns to skin and damage to eyes. May also corrode metals. Avoid skin and eye contact, and do not breathe vapors.</p>
<b>Explosive</b>		<p>May explode as a consequence of fire, heat, shock, or friction. Chemicals with this label should be kept away from potential ignition sources.</p>
<b>Compressed Gas</b>		<p>Container contains pressurized gas. This may be cold when released and explosive when heated. Containers should not be heated.</p>

<p><b>Oxidizing</b></p>		<p>Burns even in the absence of air. Can intensify fires in combustible materials. Should be kept away from ignition sources.</p>
<p><b>Toxic</b></p>		<p>Indicates life-threatening effects, in some cases even after limited exposure. Any form of ingestion and skin contact should be avoided.</p>
<p><b>Health Hazard</b></p>		<p>Short or long-term exposure could cause serious long-term health effects. Skin contact and ingestion of this material should be avoided.</p>
<p><b>Harmful/Irritant</b></p>		<p>May irritate the skin or exhibit minor toxicity. The material should be kept away from the skin and the eyes as a precaution.</p>

Indicates substances that are toxic to aquatic organisms, or substances that can cause long-lasting environmental effects. They should be disposed of responsibly.
