

VOCABULARY CARDS

Simile	Compares two things that are not alike using a connecting word such as “like” or “as.”
Metaphor	Creatively compares two things that are not alike but have something in common; there are many different types.
Extended Metaphor	A creative comparison that continues throughout a series of sentences or even an entire poem.
Implied Metaphor	Suggests a comparison without directly stating it; it hints at the comparison rather than being obvious.
Direct Metaphor	Compares two things that are not alike by directly stating that one thing <i>is</i> another.
