

VOCABULARY CARDS

Simile	compares two things that are not alike using a connecting word such as “like” or “as”
Metaphor	creatively compares two things that are not alike but have something in common; there are many different types
Extended Metaphor	a creative comparison that continues throughout a series of sentences or even an entire poem
Implied Metaphor	suggests a comparison without directly stating it; it hints at the comparison rather than being obvious
Direct Metaphor	compares two things that are not alike by directly stating that one thing <i>is</i> another
