U.S. CONSTITUTION EXCERPTS

Each of the following excerpts from the United States Constitution protect or maintain the system of slavery. With your group, read each excerpt and create a 1–2 sentence statement summarizing the excerpt.

Article 1, Section 2, Paragraph 3: "Representatives [in Congress] ... shall be [determined for each state] ... according to their [population], which shall be determined by adding to the whole Number of free Persons... three fifths of all other persons."

Article 1, Section 9, Paragraph 9: "[The] Importation of such Persons... shall not be [banned] by the Congress [before] the Year [1808]..."
