Plan #1: Reintroduction of wolves as a test (People who manage the wolves will get to decide how they treat wolves that are on private land. Wolves are less protected from what local people want.)				
Plan #2: Natural reintroduction (Wolves are reintroduced without any plans to control them or make choices about them. Wolves have no protection from what local people want.)				
Plan #3: No wolves and wolf prevention (Wolves are not reintroduced at all, and are taken out of nearby states so no wolves get into the park.)				

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Plan #4: Local groups manage the wolves (Local stakeholders form a committee that makes decisions based on the needs of the people who are affected by wolf reintroduction.)				
Plan #5: Permanent, protected wolves (Wolves are released into the park and protected from what local people want. They are allowed to live and behave without being managed or disturbed.)
