## CARD SORT

<b>What the teacher does...</b>		
<b>Generates interest and curiosity</b>	<b>Raises questions for students to consider and encourages their responses</b>	<b>Assesses current knowledge and preconceptions</b>
<b>Uses strategies to structure active student engagement in a learning topic</b>	<b>Provides opportunities for students to learn and reflect collaboratively</b>	<b>Observes and listens as students interact</b>
<b>Asks probing questions</b>	<b>Encourages and facilitates participation for all students</b>	<b>Asks for evidence and clarification</b>
<b>Leads discussions to help students connect new learning to prior knowledge</b>	<b>Encourages students to offer ideas and explanations in their own words</b>	<b>Ensures students have a common understanding of the main topic or concept of the lesson</b>
<b>Provides definitions and academic vocabulary</b>	<b>Provides students with opportunities to apply knowledge to new situations</b>	<b>Guides students to consider alternative explanations</b>

Challenges students to gain a deeper understanding of concept using new or related situation	Encourages interactions with additional resources	
<b>What the student does</b>		
Asks questions	Displays interest in the topic	Responds to ideas and questions from others
Participates actively in a set of learning experiences that relate to the topic	Actively gathers and synthesizes new information	Interacts with others during learning experiences
Shares ideas and suspends judgement	Records observations or generalizations	Participates in discussion in a positive, respectful way
Listens and then responds to the ideas of others using reasoned thinking	Uses evidence from previous activities to support explanations	Connects ideas from a learning activity to prior understanding

<b>Applies new terms and definition using appropriate academic vocabulary</b>	<b>Uses previous information and findings to ask questions, propose solutions, or make decisions</b>	<b>Pursues alternative explanations</b>
