Reflection Questions

In what ways does the lesson...

Student-Centered Opportunities

- ask students to create a product that integrates or represents their learning in a unique way?
- ask students to share ideas and respond to the ideas of others?
- allow students to make choices about their learning environment (content, process, or product)?
- allow students to assess or critique their own work?

Rigor Opportunities

- provide students with opportunities to develop and use higher-order thinking (HOT) skills (organizing, synthesizing, interpreting, integrating, evaluating)?
- use meaningful questions to guide student learning?
- ask students to construct a supported explanation or argument?
- ask students to negotiate a group understanding of a concept or idea?

Relevant Opportunities

- allow students to make personal connections with the learning activities?
- address a topic or problem that has real-world implications?

Engaging Opportunities

- place students in the role of active rather than passive learners?
- use formative assessment to link prior knowledge with new knowledge?
