Make relevant connections to personal experiences.</li> <li>Link to other sources (visuals/texts)</li> <li>Connect to family, friends, community, and the world</li> <li>"This reminds me of"</li> <li>"This is different from"</li> <li>"This made me remember when"</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ask questions.</li> <li>Ask your group: "What is the author trying to say?"</li> <li>"What if?"</li> <li>"I wonder why"</li> <li>"What might have happened before this?"</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Clarify important ideas and words after everyone has finished reading.</li> <li>Ask your group: "Is there anything anyone does not understand?"</li> <li>"Does anyone need clarification about what we read? About the meaning of a word?"</li> <li>"Does this make sense?"</li> <li>"What evidence in the text supports our earlier prediction that? Confirm or revise our prediction with evidence."</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Summarize the information in the text.</li> <li>Tell your group what the main ideas are in the text</li> <li>Select one big idea that you connect with or relate to</li> <li>"I think this page is about "</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Ask follow-up discussion questions.</li> <li>Were the predictions made at the beginning accurate?</li> <li>How has the meaning of the text changed after discussing it further?</li> <li>What is (are) the theme(s) of this story?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Identify the big idea.</li> <li>"The big idea is…"</li> <li>"This is important because…"</li> <li>"So what?"</li> <li>"I can use this information to…"</li> <li>"What essential question could fit this selection?"</li> <li>"What title would fit this selection?"</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Infer with visual images or descriptions of images.</li> <li>Use your senses (taste, hear, feel, smell, sight)</li> <li>Draw a picture</li> <li>Generate mental images</li> <li>Create a mindmap</li> </ul>
