




# A QUEST For Career Success

# Instructions **Create a K20 QUEST Account**



## To create an account on the K20 QUEST app:

1. Go to <https://quest.k20center.ou.edu/>
2. Click on the "Sign Up" button
3. Complete the information on the required fields
4. Use your email and password to access your account.

## Once you have accessed your account, you will find 4 information panels:

**My Account:** Here you will manage your account information, like your email, name, and password.

**My Students:** Here you can register your student(s).

**Bulletins:** Here you will receive notices of events important for you and your student

**Objectives:** Here you will find information and steps to prepare your student for success, before and after high school graduation - **This is where you start your journey to success!**

## To configure your account:

1. Proceed to My Student and click on "Manage Students"
2. Click on "Add Student"
3. Fill the information fields
4. Click on add student
5. If you have more than one student, you can click Add Student again and register another student

Now that you have a student, information pertinent to their school grade will populate your objectives panel. Click on the "Dashboard" link on the upper left and then on the "Start Learning" button from the "objectives" panel. You can select from any of the topics displayed and review them at your own pace.
