Establishing Tasks Follow these five steps to create successful learning stations: Decide on the number of stations and the specific task for each station. Provide each station with detailed instructions to help students complete the task. The instructions can be printed on a station handout or delivered to students' personal devices. **Defining the Objective** Define the overall learning objective for the lesson. Learning objectives outline the skills and knowledge that you want students to acquire from the lesson. WHAT IS A LEARNING STATION? **Instructions and Expectations** Learning stations are designated areas in a classroom where students rotate through Review the tasks and expectations and complete a variety of educational tasks. for each station as a class. Then, After going through all stations, students answer any questions students may have. To keep everyone on task, set participate in a class discussion to reflect on a specific time frame for students what they learned. to spend at each station. Displaying a timer is recommended. **Establishing Groups** Have students get in groups through counting off, or assign student groups ahead of time. Try to keep groups small and manageable. As students begin their work, move around the stations to provide groups with assistance. **Debriefing** Debrief each station as a class. This can be a short discussion about the task that was accomplished and the objective of each station. Use this time to connect each activity with the overall learning objective. You may

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also dispel misconceptions and address any

questions that remain.
