

K20 CAREER EXPLORATION EVENTS



ZOOM INTO YOUR CAREER

Description: Zoom Into Your Career is a series of Zoom meetings scheduled by the Mentoring team. Each meeting highlights a different career cluster and the variety of careers within the cluster. The goal is to increase students' overall knowledge of different careers.

Location: At school (exact date and time to be determined)



CAREER CAFÉ

Description: During a Career Café, a professional meets with students in-person at school or on a Zoom meeting. The professional talks to students about what their career looks like and what students must do to pursue their same career. Careers for the Cafés are chosen according to student interest, or to support specific class content.

Location: At school during a single class, homeroom, or lunch



COLLEGE2CAREER FORUM

Description: College2Career Forums (C2CF) are events that connect students' career interests with postsecondary pathways. During a C2CF, students learn more about career opportunities and the education required for different careers and experience a relevant hands-on activity.

Location: Off-site at a postsecondary institute or related location



CAREER EXPO

Description: Career Expos expose students to multiple careers at once. These events can feature multiple careers from a single career cluster, or they can feature representatives from multiple clusters. This is the in-person version of a Zoom Into Your Career event.

Location: At school or off-site
