

THIS WILL BE A SUCCESS IF...

Summary

This Will Be a Success If . . . can be used at the beginning of a lesson or learning experience to help students articulate and share their expectations. It can also serve as a formative assessment because it often reveals students' questions and concerns.

Procedure

- 1. Students complete the statement "This will be a success if . . . "
- 2. Students divide into small groups and share their responses.
- **3**. Group members combine their responses into one statement and post them somewhere in the room.
- 4. At the end of the lesson, students reflect on their experience with their "This will be a success if . . ." statements in mind. Which expectations were met? Which topics or issues should there be more information about?
