



Squiggles

Squiggles is a creative writing strategy in which students receive a random squiggly line and create a picture from it. After students complete their image, they write about what they drew.

Summary

This strategy is a fun and engaging way to inspire creativity in writing and get students thinking outside the box.

Procedure

- 1. Pass out a squiggly line to each student or have students copy a squiggle from the board.
- 2. Give students 5 minutes to add to the squiggle and turn it into a picture of their choosing.
- 3. Have students write one word, one sentence, or one paragraph about their picture, depending on their grade level.
- **4.** Have students pair up. Each student should ask one question about their partner's picture.
- Using that question, have each student add to their picture and corresponding word, sentence, or paragraph to provide more clarity and details.
