Give every student a voice, improve communication, and promote respectful listening. Qball can be used to support discussion-based learning. This throwable microphone amplifies students' voices and helps them practice their speaking skills, which can build their self-confidence. Follow these steps to integrate it into your classroom effectively:

Procedure

- Before class starts: Connect the Qball receiver to your classroom audio system (compatible with Smart Boards, projectors, and portable speakers).
- 2. Turn on the Qball using the power button. The light will indicate its status (e.g., muted or active).
- 3. Test the range (up to 75 feet) and sound quality to ensure it works well in your classroom space.
- 4. In class: Provide a discussion prompt to your students and introduce a structure such as Hot Potato.
- Demonstrate how to make eye contact with someone before passing and how to softly toss it toward them when you have their attention.
- 6. Be sure to recharge the battery after 12 hours of use.
