Summary

By utilizing a computer's microphone, the Speech Translator Chrome extension converts spoken language into real-time translated text. It supports dozens of languages and can transcribe audio from sources like videos, live streams, calls, and even in-person presentations. This is a valuable tool for teachers, presenters, and multilingual communication.

Procedure

1. Open a Google Chrome web browser
2. Go to k20.ou.edu/3a and click on "Add to Chrome."
3. In the upper right side of your Google Chrome browser, find and click on the icon that looks like a puzzle piece (the Extensions menu) and select the Speech Translator add-on.
4. Set the language that is being spoken and choose the desired language for the translated text.
5. Press "Start Listening."
6. When prompted, "Allow Use" to your device's internal microphone.
7. Begin talking or playing audio and a caption box will automatically appear on your screen with the translation.
