Summary

DebateGraph offers students a structured approach to dialogue and deliberation around a specific issue. It provides a way to visually organize the various aspects of an issue while also providing a space for elaborating upon detailed information, commenting on ideas, and rating contributions. Use this tool to facilitate and record group dialogue, reach a consensus, share ideas, or explore connections between concepts.

Procedure

1. Navigate to [debategraph](https://debategraph.org/).
2. Log in or create an account.
3. Select **Map**.
4. Select **Start a new map**.
5. Enter a heading.
6. Enter a summary (optional).
7. Select **Finish**.
8. Follow the prompts and read the help text provided by DebateGraph to continue building a map to suit your needs.
